## Scholarship Application

### VFW POST 311 Commander's Scholarship 2014

1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is Friday, June 20, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**
2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.

**PURPOSE** The VFW Post 311 Commander's Scholarship Fund was established in 2013. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals, who are descendants of Veterans, enrolled for undergraduate study in community colleges, colleges, and universities. The VFW Post 311 Commander's Scholarship targets two and four year academic programs.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** is based on financial need, academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in VFW Post 311 programs. Scholarships are awarded and/ or renewed annually provided funds are available. In addition, the scholarship may be renewed provided the award recipient meets the conditions outlined below in *Scholarship Renewal*.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

The VFW Post 311 of Richton Park awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Personal Essay and Financial Need. VFW Post 311 pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient's school. Scholarships are awarded each academic year and may continue each academic year if the student maintains a 2.5 GPA each semester. The VFW Post 311 Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

## **CRITERIA**

- Applicants must be a descendant of an honorably discharged veteran.
- Applicants must have permanent residence status in Illinois and NW Indiana.
- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum un-weighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college or university for the upcoming academic year.
- Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- Preference may be given to applicants who have participated in VFW Post 311 programs.
- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Student must submit a copy of their 2013-2014 Student Aid Report (SAR) from Free Application for Federal Student Aid/(FAFSA)
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by Friday, **June 20, 2014**.
- Scholarship recipients will receive their check for the next academic year **only** after their grades from the previous semester have been received.

## **TIMELINE**

- Both new and renewal applications are due **June 20, 2014**.
- Candidates that are eligible for interviews will be notified by the Scholarship Committee by early July 2014.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by the end of July 2014.

## **Application Process**

### **NEW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:**

- Completed application form.
- DD Form 214. You must be a son or daughter, granddaughter or grandson, great-granddaughter or great-grandson, brother or sister, or wife or husband of a veteran.
- Official high school/college transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution.
- Two academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A letter completed reference from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic institution for post-secondary studies.
- Demonstrated financial need.

### **SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:**

- Scholarships may be renewed annually if entering a full time program, and up to three times for a total of 4 years of study, if recipients maintain a 2.5 average GPA and complete. More than 3 renewals may be considered on a case by case basis. This presupposes that funds are available for disbursement.
- The scholarship recipient must demonstrate need for continued financial assistance.
- A personal statement describing their experience during their academic year and what they have learned that will help them move forward in life.
- Completed application form.
- The Scholarship recipient must retain permanent residence status in Illinois or NW Indiana.

## **SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE *Continued.***

- Students must provide a transcript for consideration. Students may provide a transcript printed from an online college record through the prior semester or an official transcript. Awards will be made provisionally pending receipt of final grades from that academic year.
- Renewal applications are due by **Friday, June 20, 2014.**

## **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

- Award notification will be given by the end of July 2014.
- Applicant must provide their **student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be received.**
- Award amounts will be distributed each academic year after a student's **final grades are received by VFW Post 311.**

## **CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS**

- All recipients must apply for a Pell Grant.
- If applicant is awarded a scholarship, the recipient must agree that VFW Post 311 may use their name and academic information in new releases or promotional publications regarding this award.
- Scholarship recipients will receive their check for the next academic year only after their grades from the previous academic year have been received. Students must receive a 2.5 grade point average based on a 4.0 scale.

**Deadline** for the application is Friday, **June 20, 2014.** Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
